



How do I

... check out books,
DVDs, and/or CDs?

To check out materials you will need to have a library card with you when you come to the library.

What cannot be checked out?

You may not check out textbooks, reference books, magazines, toys, or big books.

... know when to bring things back?

When you check out you will be given a receipt that has the titles of what you are borrowing and the date they are due.

DON'T LOSE THE RECEIPT!
Everything will be due in 14 days (2 weeks).

... get a library card?

To get a library card you must ...

- Be at least age 3 or above
- Live, work, or attend school in Auburn, Alabama
- If you are under age 18 you must have a parent or guardian come into the library and fill out a form for you

... know when the library is open?

The library is open 7 days a week.
