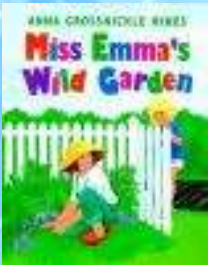
St. Patrick's Day Song

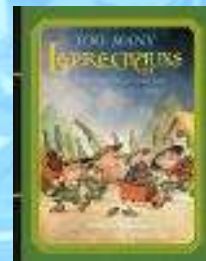

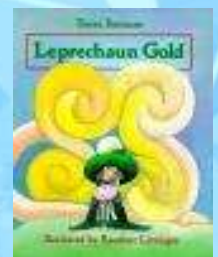
