The Auburn Preservation League will present its 11th annual Loveliest Village Christmas Tour of Homes and Buildings on Saturday, Dec. 9, from 10 a.m.-4 p.m., and Sunday, Dec. 10, from 1-4 p.m.

Proceeds from this year's event will be used to cover the costs of providing limited renovations or repairs to homes in Auburn built before 1940. Eligible homes must be owner occupied by senior citizens (those 70 and older), veterans or low-income residents.

The APL plans to select one home for this new initiative in 2017 with work occurring in 2018.
